Mertice "Floy" Townsend Standard, 92, passed away on December 6, 2012 at the Desert Life Nursing Facility in Tucson, AZ.

She was born to Charles Edman & Clara Tweet Harrison Townsend on May 31, 1920 in Llano, TX. She graduated from school while she was living in Artesia, NM and then went to work in Artesia as a dental assistant.
