KANSAS CITY, Mo. – Shawn Leann Walker, 53, died April 1st, 2014, at the Kansas City Hospice and Palliative Care Center in Kansas City, Mo. after a long battle with ovarian cancer.

Because of the rare nature of her cancer and her desire to prevent the suffering of others, Shawn's wishes were to have her body donated to scientific research. Her remains will later be interred at the site of her father's grave in Emporia.
