



Western Avenue has been undergoing construction this week related to the city's Western Avenue re-pavement project. Public Works Director Joe Sealey explained the pre-project work currently taking place: "We're doing a little preventative stuff – replacing the lines that go under Western Avenue so we don't come back and dig a new road up a year after we get it down," he said. "It will cause the traffic to be one lane each direction and cover basically from Second Street and Western south to the Union Pacific railroad tracks."
