Interested in fresh, home cooking in fast-food style? The South Church of God will be providing carhop service in an effort to raise funds for a youth conference in Wichita. Youth Pastor Laurent Vincent said the meal will be available for purchase from 5 to 7 p.m. Saturday at the South Church of God. Meal prices, she said, are yet to be determined.

“The community will just drive up and park in grass lots,” Vincent said. “The youth will come out and get their order. We are just going to have a simple menu. We will have hamburgers, homemade french fries and soda.”
