Beginning the 2009-2010 school year, immunization requirements for students attending
Kansas public schools will be changing. The new vaccine requirements are as follows:
o One dose of varicella (chickenpox) vaccine for all 1st through 9th graders unless history of
disease documented by licensed physician.
o Two doses of varicella (chickenpox) vaccine for all preschool and kindergarten students
unless history of disease documented by licensed physician.
o Three doses of Hepatitis B for all students preschool through 9th grade.
o One booster dose of Tdap for students 11 years of age if it has been more than 2 years since
the previous dose of DTaP/DT/Td.
o Three doses of Haemophilus influenza type b (Hib) vaccine for all preschool students.
o Four doses of pneumococcal conjugate (PCV7) vaccine for all preschool students.
