Earlier this month, law enforcement authorities arrested 25 people on alleged drug charges, according to a statement released Monday by the Seward County Sheriff's Department.

"On Wednesday, Oct. 7, the Seward County Sheriff's Office, with the assistance of Liberal Police Department, the Kansas Bureau of Investigations Drug Task Force, Beaver County Sheriff's Office K-9 unit and the Tyrone Police Department K-9 Officer, ended a 9-month- long investigation that led to 11 search warrants in connection with suspected drug activity," the release noted.

"Officers began serving the search warrants at approximately 2 p.m.

on Wednesday and ended the operation on Thursday afternoon. During the operation, 25 people were arrested on felony drug charges:
