TEXHOMA, Okla. — Dayton Metcalf scored 17 and Brandon Gomez 15 — including four 3-pointers — to lead the Hooker Bulldogs to a 62-43 win over Texhoma on Friday night.

After Texhoma's Dylan Koehn drained a three to give the Red Devils a 4-2 lead early in the first quarter, the Bulldogs took over.

Hunter Brown hit the second of two free throws to cut the Texhoma lead to 4-3 — and that was the last time the Red Devils would have the advantage.

Hooker (1-2) went on a 7-0 run behind Dayton Metcalf and Taylor McBee as Texhoma turned it over three times in that stretch, including a Metcalf steal.

Moises Garay and Ramy Andersom brought Texhoma (1-2) to within 10-8, but a basket by John Godfrey and the first of Gomez's treys gave the Bulldogs the lead for good.

Up 15-8, Gomez hit a 3-pointer to make it 18-8, Brown made it 20-10 and Gomez made it 23-10 in favor of Hooker.

Gomez, Brown, Metcalf and Godfrey put the Bulldogs up 36-17 at one point before Koehn and Brad Ferguson cut it to 38-21 at halftime.

Hooker led 56-33 after the third quarter and coasted to the 19-point win.

In addition to Metcalf and Gomez, Brown scored 11 and Godfrey 10 for the Bulldogs.

Koehn led Texhoma with 14 and Nathan Knitig added 11 to pace Texhoma.

Next up for Texhoma is a home game Monday against the Keyes Pirates, while Hooker visits Turpin on Tuesday before heading to the Blue & Red Classic in Hugoton, Kan. next weekend.
