For the second time this season, Seward County sophomores Erin Roufousse and Brittany Kent have been named the KJCCC Players of the Week.

Roufousse was simply dominate this week in two starts against Jayhawk competition as first she twirled a 3 hit shutout in a huge 4-0 win over 20th ranked Butler on Tuesday and backed that up with an even better performance with a 1 hit shutout against Dodge City where she struck out 11 without walking a batter.

She finished the week with a spotless 0.00 ERA and 16 strikeouts compared to just 2 walks.

Kent earns the award for the second straight week as she continued to swing a hot bat hitting .636 with 5 RBI's in four Seward County wins.

She recorded 7 hits in four games including a double and two triples and finished the week with a 1.091 slugging percentage.
