TEXHOMA, Okla. — The top-ranked Forgan Bulldogs got off to a slow start in a tough environment at Texhoma on Friday night, but was able to pull away in the second half to post a 61-33.

Forgan ends the regular season with a 20-2 overall record and will head to Yarbrough on Friday for the district tournament.

Texhoma (9-10) trailed just 13-11 after the first period and 28-20 at the half. But Forgan went on a 21-6 run in the third period to break it open.

Rhett Radcliff and Tanner Jones led Forgan's balanced attack with 16 points each, while Jake Regier added 10. Jacob Murphy added 14 in the paint to lead Texhoma.
