

Friday, Feb. 28, and Saturday, March 1, weather forecast

Friday, 28 February 2014 11:07

Tonight: Increasing clouds, with a low around 23. Blustery, with an east northeast wind 15 to 20 mph decreasing to 9 to 14 mph after midnight.

Saturday: A slight chance of drizzle between 3 and 5 p.m., then a slight chance of freezing drizzle after 5 p.m.. Cloudy, with a high near 33. Breezy, with an east wind 13 to 20 mph, with gusts as high as 33 mph.

Saturday night: A chance of freezing drizzle and sleet before midnight, then sleet likely between midnight and 5 a.m., then sleet likely, possibly mixed with snow after 5 a.m. Cloudy, with a low around 11. Wind chill values as low as -6. Blustery, with an east northeast wind 16 to 21 mph, with gusts as high as 34 mph. Chance of precipitation is 60 percent. New snow and sleet accumulation of less than a half inch possible.
