Kelly, who spent 340 days in space during his mission on the International Space Station, shared his experiences and insights into life in space. He discussed the challenges of living in a microgravity environment, the effects of space travel on the human body, and the future of space exploration. Kelly's lecture was part of a series of events celebrating his mission and the achievements of NASA's space program.
