Board approves budget adjustment, begins strategic planning

 The board of trustees for the Liberal Unified School District (LUSD) has approved a budget adjustment and begun strategic planning for the 2013-2014 fiscal year. The board, which met on Monday, April 8, at the district's headquarters in Liberal, approved a budget that includes a 1.5 percent millage rate increase. Board member David Diaperrock said the increase is necessary to maintain the district's current level of services. He also said the board will begin strategic planning for the next fiscal year, which will include reviewing the district's long-term goals and objectives.

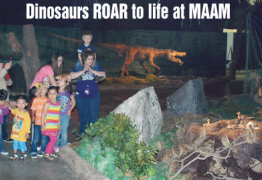
