State explains increased employment numbers

The State of Iowa has experienced an increase in employment numbers in the first quarter of 2013. According to the Iowa Department of Economic Development, the state added 1,200 jobs in the first quarter, bringing the total number of jobs in the state to 2.8 million. The increase in employment is primarily due to growth in the manufacturing and services sectors. The manufacturing sector added 800 jobs, while the services sector added 400 jobs. The construction sector also saw an increase in employment, adding 200 jobs. The increase in employment is a positive sign for the state's economy, but it also highlights the need for continued investment in education and workforce development.
