Pedestrian may be facing charges after being hit by vehicle when crossing 15th

A vehicle roll-over on 15th Street in Liberty, Mo., on Tuesday night injured another pedestrian, who may be facing charges. The incident occurred at the intersection of 15th Street and Main Street. The driver of the vehicle, a 2011 Ford Focus, was cited for driving on the wrong side of the road and for failing to yield to a pedestrian. The pedestrian, a 35-year-old male, was taken to a local hospital with injuries to his leg and arm. The driver is being held on a \$10,000 bond.
