### Routine blood test saved baby's life

#### MCADD a silent killer for many

**A** 14-month-old baby, looking healthy and happy, looked like any other baby. But his parents, Colleen and Morgan, knew that only knew after his death, he was a perfect angel from death.

Colleen and Morgan knew in 2011 that their son, Luca, was not eating well. They noticed he was losing weight and was not growing. They took him to the pediatrician, who ran a series of tests. The doctor told them that Luca had a rare condition called medium-chain acyl-CoA dehydrogenase deficiency (MCADD). It is a genetic disorder that affects the body's ability to break down fats for energy. Luca's condition was so severe that he had to be hospitalized several times. The doctor told them that Luca had a 50 percent chance of dying from the condition.
