### Routine blood test saved baby's life

#### MCADD a silent killer for many

**A** 14-month-old baby, who looked healthy and happy, died last week because of a rare genetic condition called medium-chain acyl-CoA dehydrogenase deficiency (MCADD). The condition is a type of fatty acid oxidation disorder that causes the body to be unable to break down certain fats into energy. It is a silent killer for many children.

Parents, Colleen and Morgan, found out about their son's condition when he was 14 months old. They had noticed that he was not gaining weight and was often sick. After a routine blood test, they discovered that he had MCADD. The doctor told them that the condition was rare and that they would need to start a special diet to help their son live a normal life.

Colleen and Morgan are now working with a dietitian to help their son eat the right foods. They also have to be careful about what they eat themselves because they need to eat the same foods as their son. It has been a challenge, but they are determined to give their son the best life possible.
