A: Look for a facility that is clean, safe, and well-maintained. The staff should be trained and qualified. The facility should have a good reputation and a history of providing quality care.

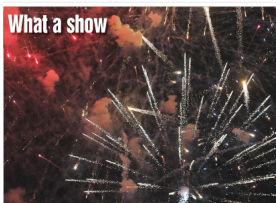
Q: How can I ensure my child's safety?
