Common questions about day care facilities

Parents often have questions about day care facilities, especially when they are considering options for their children. Here are some common questions and answers to help you make a decision.

Q: How do I choose a day care facility?
A: Start by asking for recommendations from friends and family. Visit the facility and talk to the director. Check the facility's license and accreditation. Ask to see the children and talk to the staff.

Q: What should I look for in a day care facility?
A: Look for a clean, safe, and nurturing environment. The staff should be trained and qualified. The facility should have a good reputation and be licensed.

Q: How much does day care cost?
A: Day care costs can vary widely depending on the location and the type of facility. Some facilities offer sliding scale fees based on family income.

Q: How do I know if my child is ready for day care?
A: Your child should be able to separate from you without a major meltdown. They should be able to follow simple instructions and play independently.
