Missouri/Kansas see increase in drowning deaths

Missouri and Kansas have seen an increase in drowning deaths over the past few years, according to a report from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. The report shows that drowning is the leading cause of death for children aged 1 to 14 in both states. In Missouri, there were 107 drowning deaths in 2011, up from 93 in 2010. In Kansas, there were 87 drowning deaths in 2011, up from 73 in 2010.
