Witness reveals location of drug source in corn field

Three federal drug agents, two of whom are members of the FBI's elite Joint Task Force, have revealed the location of a marijuana source in a corn field in Lawrence, Kan., during the second day of a trial.

The source, a man who has been identified as a "marijuana grower," is accused of supplying marijuana to a network of distributors in the Lawrence area. The source is accused of growing marijuana in a corn field located near the intersection of 10th and 11th streets in Lawrence.
