A 3-ton elephant accidentally killed a Missouri zookeeper on Saturday, Oct. 12, at the Missouri State Zoo. The elephant, named "Bobby," was in the process of eating a large piece of hay when it accidentally bit down on the zookeeper's neck. The zookeeper, named "John," was 45 years old and had been working at the zoo for 15 years. Bobby was immediately put to death by a veterinarian. The incident is the first of its kind at the Missouri State Zoo.
