Many exchange health plans exclude top hospitals
A study has found that many health exchange plans do not cover care at top hospitals. The study, conducted by the Kaiser Family Foundation, found that 40 percent of exchange plans do not cover care at one or more of the top 100 hospitals in the United States. The study also found that many exchange plans have high deductibles and out-of-pocket maximums, which can make it difficult for people to afford care.
