when decorating

The holidays are a time for joy and celebration, but they can also be a time for accidents and injuries. To help you stay safe while decorating for the holidays, here are some tips from the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA):
• Use ladders properly. Always use a ladder that is the right height for the job. Make sure the ladder is on a level surface and is fully extended. Do not overreach. Always use three points of contact (two hands and one foot, or two feet and one hand) when climbing or descending.
• Use caution with electrical decorations. Do not use electrical decorations if they are frayed, damaged or have loose wires. Do not use electrical decorations outdoors unless they are specifically designed for outdoor use. Do not use electrical decorations near water or other liquids.
• Use caution with candles. Do not use candles if you are unable to watch them at all times. Do not use candles in paper, fabric or plastic decorations. Do not use candles in areas with flammable materials. Do not use candles in areas with children or pets.
• Use caution with string lights. Do not use string lights if they are frayed, damaged or have loose wires. Do not use string lights outdoors unless they are specifically designed for outdoor use. Do not use string lights near water or other liquids.
