Asian nations dominate international test

WASHINGTON (AP) — Asian nations dominated an international test of mathematics and science skills, with South Korea and Singapore leading the way. The results of the Program for International Student Assessment (PISA) were announced Tuesday by the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD).

South Korea topped the list in mathematics, scoring an average of 554 points, followed by Singapore at 553. The United States scored 489, which is about the same as the average for all countries. Japan and Canada also performed well, with scores of 548 and 547, respectively.

In science, Singapore led with 561 points, followed by South Korea at 554. The United States scored 492, which is slightly above the average for all countries. Japan and Canada also performed well, with scores of 548 and 547, respectively.

The PISA test is a major international assessment of students' skills in mathematics, science and reading. It is designed to measure the extent to which students have acquired the knowledge and skills that are essential for life and work in the 21st century.
