County looks to spend \$100K to stop concealed carry in 2 buildings

Commission may request 4-year exemption from concealed carry law before spending on security

The Seward County Board of Commissioners is considering a resolution to request a four-year exemption from the state's concealed carry law for two buildings in Seward County. The resolution would allow the county to spend up to \$100,000 on security measures for the buildings. The buildings are the Seward County Courthouse and the Seward County Jail. The county is currently spending about \$50,000 a year on security for these buildings. The resolution would allow the county to spend up to \$100,000 a year on security measures for the buildings.
