### County looks to spend \$100K to stop concealed carry in 2 buildings

Commission may request 4-year exemption from concealed carry law before spending on security

The Seward County Board of Commissioners is considering a resolution to request a four-year exemption from the state's concealed carry law for two buildings in Seward County. The exemption would allow the county to spend up to \$100,000 on security measures for the buildings. The buildings are the Seward County Courthouse and the Seward County Jail. The exemption would expire on December 31, 2017. The resolution was introduced by Commissioner Dan K. Kiser.
