Feds collect \$12.1 million in Kansas

U.S. Attorney's Office in Kansas collects \$12.1 million in civil and criminal actions for U.S. taxpayers in fiscal year 2013
KANSAS CITY, Mo. — U.S. Attorney Russ Krumholz announced Tuesday that the U.S. Attorney's Office in Kansas collected \$12.1 million in civil and criminal actions for U.S. taxpayers in fiscal year 2013. The total amount includes \$8.5 million in civil actions and \$3.6 million in criminal actions. The office handled 1,200 cases during the year, including 800 civil and 400 criminal cases. The actions resulted in the recovery of \$12.1 million for the federal government. The office also secured 150 years of probation and 100 years of imprisonment for defendants.
