Survey says: 'Scale back'
Vision Team tightens scope, price tag of bond issue

It won't be possible to raise the bond issue for \$100 million, according to a survey of voters conducted by the Vision Team. The survey, which was conducted in November, found that 68 percent of voters would support a bond issue of \$50 million, but only 38 percent would support a bond issue of \$100 million. The survey also found that 75 percent of voters would support a bond issue of \$50 million if it were used to fund a variety of projects, but only 45 percent would support a bond issue of \$100 million if it were used to fund a single project.
