The transcript of a meeting between top defense officials and President Obama on the night of the Benghazi attack is being released. The transcript shows that the officials briefed Obama on the attack as a terrorist attack, rather than a video or protest. The transcript also shows that the officials discussed the possibility of a demonstration and a protest, but ultimately concluded that the attack was a terrorist attack.
