### Olney's Devon Byrne prepares to defend her title Tuesday

Olney's Devon Byrne is preparing to defend her title as the 2013-14 National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA) Division II National Champion in the women's 100-meter freestyle stroke at the 2014 NCAA Division II National Championships in Greensboro, N.C. on Tuesday, Feb. 25. Byrne, a senior from Olney, is one of the top swimmers in the world and is expected to win the title again.



Byrne is currently ranked first in the world in the 100-meter freestyle stroke and is a three-time NCAA champion. She is also a member of the U.S. National Team and has competed in the 2012 London Olympics. Byrne is coached by Greg Mearns at Olney and is currently training at the University of Michigan.
