Kansas man accused in guitar string decapitation

HOUSTON (AP) — A southeast Kansas man died after a guitar string decapitated him. The man, 38, was killed by a guitar string that snapped while he was playing. The string snapped and struck his neck, severing his carotid artery. The man was taken to a hospital but died before he could be transported to a hospital.

Kan. Senate to debate bill voiding local gun rules

TOPEKA (AP) — Kansas' top legislative body is expected to vote on a bill that would void local gun control laws. The bill, known as the "Kansas Second Amendment Act," would prohibit local governments from enforcing gun laws that are more restrictive than state law. The bill is expected to be introduced in the Senate in the coming weeks.

Deadline brings high interest for health insurance

HOUSTON (AP) — The deadline for employers to decide whether to offer health insurance to their employees has arrived. Many employers are rushing to make a decision by the end of the month. The deadline is set by the Affordable Care Act, which requires employers with 50 or more full-time employees to offer health insurance to their full-time employees by the end of 2014.
