The City of Coronado (population 4,000) and the School District of Coronado (population 4,000) are set to approve a sales tax agreement today. The agreement gives the city the authority to raise the sales tax from 2.5 percent to 3.5 percent. The school district will receive an additional \$1 million in revenue. The agreement also allows the city to use the revenue for a variety of purposes, including the construction of a new school building. The agreement is expected to be approved by the city council and the school board today.
