### Newly obtained Benghazi emails suggest White House aide involved in prepping Rice for 'video' explanation

A newly obtained email suggests a White House aide was involved in preparing Secretary of State Hillary Clinton for a video explanation of the 2012 Benghazi attack. The email, dated April 23, 2013, shows the aide, identified as a senior White House official, discussing the need for a video that would explain the attack to the public.
