Newly obtained Benghazi emails suggest White House aide involved in prepping Rice for 'video' explanation

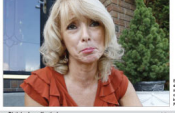

A review of newly obtained emails suggests a White House aide was involved in preparing Secretary of State Hillary Clinton for a video explanation of the 2012 Benghazi attack. The emails, which were obtained through a Freedom of Information Act request, show that the aide was involved in drafting a script for the video. The aide's name is not mentioned in the emails, but the script was dated to the day before the attack. The emails also show that the aide was involved in discussing the video with other White House officials.
